01. Workers Welfare & Accountable Leadership

- Prompt Salary and Pension payments
- Review of Low cost Housing/Car Loans system for Civil Servants
- Prompt payment of Imprest for smooth running of offices
- Employment of Civil Servants and Improved welfare package for workers in the State.
- Digital governance platforms
- Training & Retraining of workers
- Ensuring Local Government Autonomy Compliance
- Ensuring transparency and accountability in governance





02. Agriculture

- Position Osun to be the regional food hub
- Off season irrigation along riverbanks.
- Establishment of Farm Estates at the 3 senatorial districts
- Putting five Agric extension officers in each local government to assist farmers
- Establishment of farmers' market in urban centres, and the establishment of drying and pressing plants
- Provision of 62 tractors and mechanized farming implements (two per local governments)
- Off-taking, marketing, and price guarantee of farm produce
- Agro-processing hubs
- Farmer financing programs and provision of farm input support
- Development of 1000 hectares Farm Estate/Settlement in the State
- Resuscitation of Qlōba Cattle Ranch and empowerment of graduates and agriculture entrepreneurs in poultry and other animals farming.

Security & Territorial Protection

- Community policing
- Surveillance systems
- Provision of monthly stipends to security agents in the state
- Mapping entry/exit points in border towns
- Provision of security amenities and equipment support to the state's security formations
- Community policing and engagement of traditional rulers and youths in the security architecture





04. Education

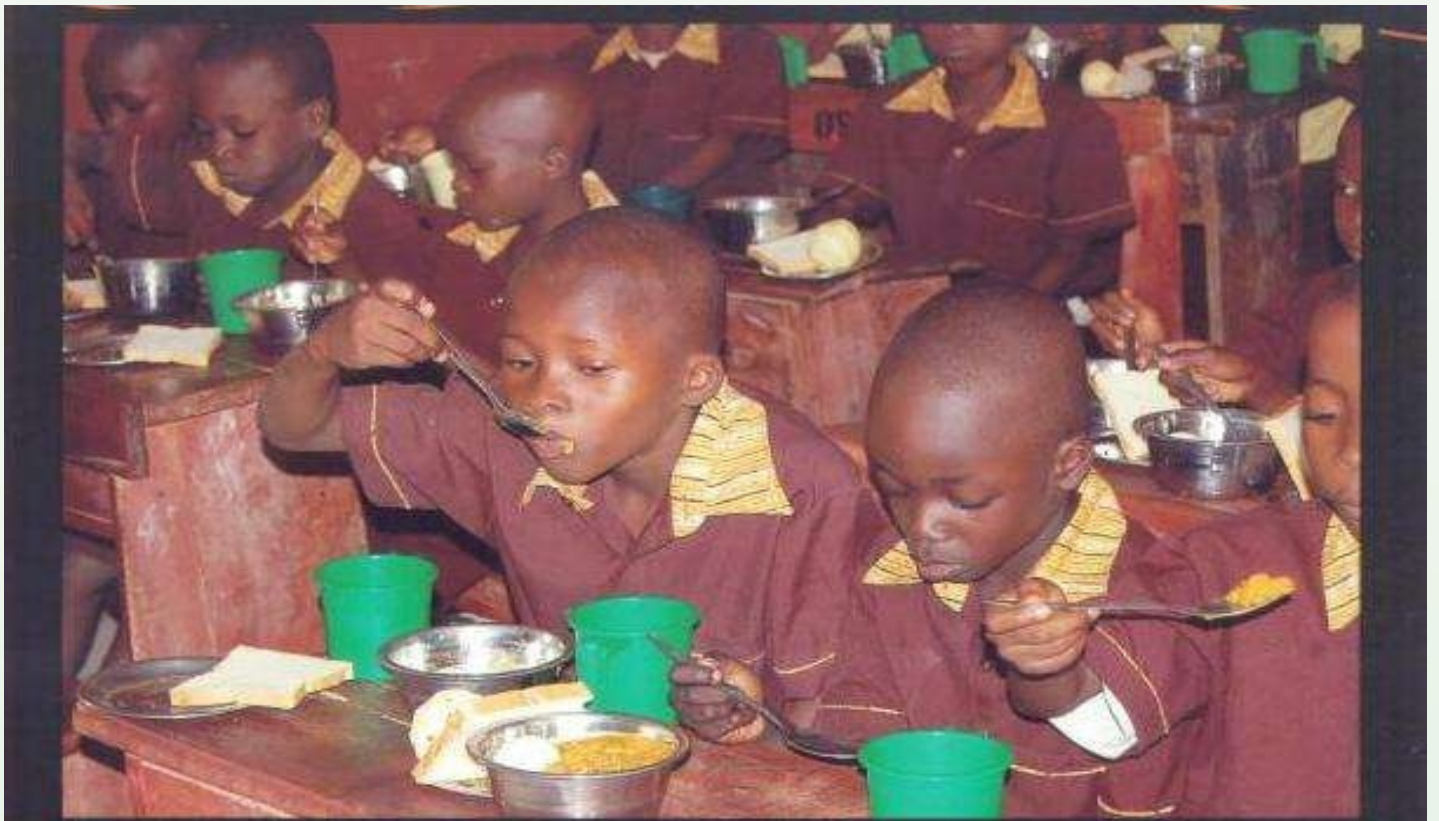
- Re-introduction of the School Feeding Program
- Free Education from Elementary to Secondary Education
- Bursary and scholarship awards to tertiary students
- Enhancements of inspectorate division in public schools



- Sports development in public schools
- School upgrades and Construction
- The return of calisthenics
- Annual awards for excellence in education.



- Recruiting more teachers (where needed), regular training and retraining and improved welfare package for education workers.
- Review of the school syllabus and introduction of skills acquisition for self reliance and entrepreneurship at both secondary and tertiary levels
- Enhancement of Technical Education
- Digital learning systems and upgrade of ICT laboratories at our schools.





05. Infrastructure & Power

- Establishment of 213 megawatts alternative power plant/system each at the 3 senatorial districts in Osun
- Rehabilitation and Construction of at least 10kilometer roads per Local Government.
- Construction of Rural access roads
- Electrification of all rural communities in Osun
- Urban Renewal and Development
- Community based infrastructure maintenance system





- Resuscitation of moribund infrastructures through public private partnership scheme (PPP)
- Provision of rural borehole system in each local government
- Judiciary: Construction of new state of the art courts and Renovation of dilapidated buildings in the judiciary.
- Evaluation and completion of the abandoned House of Assembly Members' Quarters

Youth Engagement, Job Creation & Social Welfare

- Re-establishment of the O-YES SCHEME with employment of 20,000 cadets in the first 100 days of the government.
- Reintroduction of Agba Oşun with Monthly Allowance and free medical treatment to ALL senior citizens from 70 years and above who are without pension.
- Re-establishment of OMOLUABI Youths, Boys and Girls Club for character building instilling Omoluabi Ethos
- Special attention to the people living with disabilities and establishment of rehabilitation centres
- Introduction of apprenticeship Programme with monthly allowance and provision of tools and startup capital upon completion of training.
- Skill acquisition programmes
- Establishment of Technology Innovation Hubs
- Startup funding support scheme
- Resuscitation of the Osun Job Centre with focus on job creation, trainings, and innovation.
- Establishment of one Sport Arena at each Federal Constituency of the State.



07. Health

- Revamp and upgrade of 332 primary health centres
- Free Ante-natal care for women
- Free health care for children from age 1-18years
- Establishment of a state of the art SPECIALIST hospital with diagnostic and interventional radiology centres at the 3 senatorial districts for proper accessibility through a public private partnership model for adequate sustainability.
- The upgrade of existing state hospitals.
- Recruit health professionals
- Expand insurance coverage
- Resuscitation of the Osun Pharmaceutical Company through a public private partnership model
- Resuscitation of the O-AMBULANCE system at every local government of the state and at major federal and state roads.

Women Empowerment & Inclusion

- Inclusion of at least 35 percent women in the government structure
- Support for women businesses
- Introduction of Women Protection policies
- N1 billion annual loan for women entrepreneurs.



09. Culture, Tourism And Community Engagements

- Upgrade of tourism sites in the state
- Development of resorts and hospitality centers at the 3 senatorial districts.
- Promotion of cultural festivals
- Improvement of tourism infrastructure and site around the state.
- Establishment of an active community sanitation systems
- Periodic town hall governance meetings and engagements
- Introduction of grassroots participation mechanism



10. Investments Facilitation & SME Empowerment

- Resuscitation of the Osun State Investment Promotion Agency
- Provision of loans and grants for SMEs
- Re-introduction of broad based cooperative enhancement system
- Business support programs
- Product off-take and marketing of Made-in-Osun products.
- Enhancement of the One-Stop-Shop to improve Ease Of Doing Business in the State.
